Riverwalk COVID-19 Update

Riverwalk Town Centre

Development Victoria is in the process of preparing an Expression of Interest campaign to secure an Agreement for Lease for a full-range supermarket with one of the major supermarket operators. Once a supermarket operator is on board, Development Victoria will commence the process of divesting the Town Centre site to a competent and reputable developer.

The new Town Centre will include a supermarket and smaller retail outlets. The development will also include townhouse style residences to enhance the connection between commercial and residential areas within the Riverwalk community.



Alfred Road Intersection

The construction of the four-way signalised intersection at the junction of Alfred Road, Coldstream Avenue and Geelong Road has commenced.

Construction of this intersection includes **upgrading** a 500-metre section of Geelong Road which borders Riverwalk and will form a key frontage to the estate. Upon completion of these works, residents and visitors of Riverwalk will be able to access Geelong Road directly from the estate via Coldstream Avenue.

The resurfacing of Geelong Road and associated intersection works will greatly improve drainage and safety conditions for users of Geelong Road. The project will be delivered using traffic management conditions, allowing Geelong Road to remain open at all times. The project involves constructing a new road pavement in Alfred Road over an existing high-pressure gas pipeline. Given the sensitivity of this pipeline and the complex nature of building over the asset, the timeframe for the project is lengthier than other similar works. The intersection is anticipated to be completed within 12 months.

Road detours are now in place to assist with traffic in the area and Development Victoria appreciates the patience of all residents. We are anticipating completing these works by early 2021.

Keeping Riverwalk Clean

Development Victoria is working in collaboration with Wyndham City Council and the Werribee River Association to reduce litter and building debris throughout the Riverwalk Estate. We are passionate about keeping our environment clean, and the shared community spaces within Riverwalk looking their best.

The project aims to encourage better waste practices on building sites and raise awareness of the financial and environmental impacts of litter by providing building sites with signage and litter bags. To help enforce this, there will also be an increase in the frequency of building site inspections.

In addition to this project, Development Victoria will be installing surveillance cameras in areas under construction for the safety of residents and to discourage illegal dumping.

Sports Oval

Progress is now being made on the sports oval site, with Development Victoria's contractor progressing with works. Contractors Excell Gray Bruni are currently preparing the 4.5ha site for title and transfer to Wyndham City Council, and it is anticipated that the land will be handed to Council by mid-2020.

Once transferred, the site will be developed by Council for active recreation in accordance with the Riverwalk Development Plan.
