An Early Leaning Centre will also be built on the site which is scheduled to

Water Play at the Village Park

Development Victoria's maintenance responsibilities for the Riverwalk Village Centre park have now concluded. The park and water play areas are now owned and operated by Wyndham City Council. The new operating hours for the water park are as follows: 8am to 8pm (October 31 - April 30) The water park will be closed from May through to the end of September.

Backed by a strong consensus from the community, Development Victoria is pleased to announce that the naming poll for the new park in Stage 20 has closed and a clear preference has emerged.

The Office of Geographic Names has formally approved the new name for this reserve as Liberator Park. Landscaping works in the park have now reached completion and it will be officially open for use by the public in coming months. Facilities include a barbeque, drinking fountain, basketball half-court, children's play area and swings, along with park benches and decking area overlooking the adjoining wetlands.



Liberator Park New Sales and Information Centre

The new Riverwalk Sales and Information Centre commenced construction in January 2020 and will provide a new state-ofthe-art hub for the Riverwalk sales team.

This unique building has been designed by Hayball architects with landscape design by Outlines Landscape Architecture. The facility will include a café space for the community to mingle and enjoy a morning coffee. Development Victoria has appointed Tandem Building Group to deliver the new facility.



Riverwalk Town Centre

Plans for the new Riverwalk Town Centre are progressing well with the recent engagement of CBRE as Development Victoria's agent for transacting on the retail component of the site.

An expression of interest is scheduled to be released in early 2020 for a competent and reputable Town Centre developer to deliver the retail core at the heart of Riverwalk, as per the Development Plan.

We look forward to sharing detailed plans of the Riverwalk Town Centre concepts in the next few months.



Sports Oval

Works have now commenced to level the Riverwalk sports oval and deliver drainage and property services required to title the site and transfer the 4.5 ha sports field to Wyndham City Council. Once transferred, the site will be developed by Council for active recreation in accordance with the Riverwalk Development Plan.

Another exciting opportunity has also arisen to deliver a second sports oval at Riverwalk adjacent to the current Melbourne Water Discovery Centre. This newly proposed sports field is in excess of 3 hectares in land area and was not included in the original Riverwalk Development Plan. If formally approved by Council, the new sports oval will provide a fantastic new piece of amenity for residents, in addition to the features included in Riverwalk's original masterplan.

ALFRED ROAD

Alfred Road Signalised Intersection

Excell Gray Bruni has been appointed as the civil contractor for the construction of the fourway signalised intersection at the junction of Alfred Road, Coldstream Avenue and Princes Highway. This inter-



section is a significant gateway into the Riverwalk Estate and provides an integral link to the new Riverwalk Primary School from the neighbouring residential areas to the west. The construction of this intersection includes upgrading a 500-metre section of the Princes Highway (Geelong Road) which borders Riverwalk and will form a key frontage to the estate. The Department of Transport and Wyndham City Council are key partners and stakeholders in the delivery of this important piece of infrastructure for the Werribee community. Construction is scheduled to commence in early 2020.
